Nature of the Tour:

Chimhavira offer you 5 days in the Kruger National Park. The Kruger National Park is one of the largest game reserves in Africa. It covers 18,989 square kilometres (7,332 sq mi) and extends 360 kilometres (220 mi) from north to south and 65 kilometres (40 mi) from east to west.

To the west and south of the Kruger National Park are the two South African provinces of Limpopo and Mpumalanga. In the north is Zimbabwe, and to the east is Mozambique. It is now part of the Great Limpopo Transfrontier Park, a peace park that links Kruger National Park with the Gonarezhou National Park in Zimbabwe, and with the Limpopo National Park in Mozambique.

The group will consist of a maximum of eight participants plus a professional guide whom will drive the back-up vehicle and will meet up with you at the campsites in the evening and be your host.

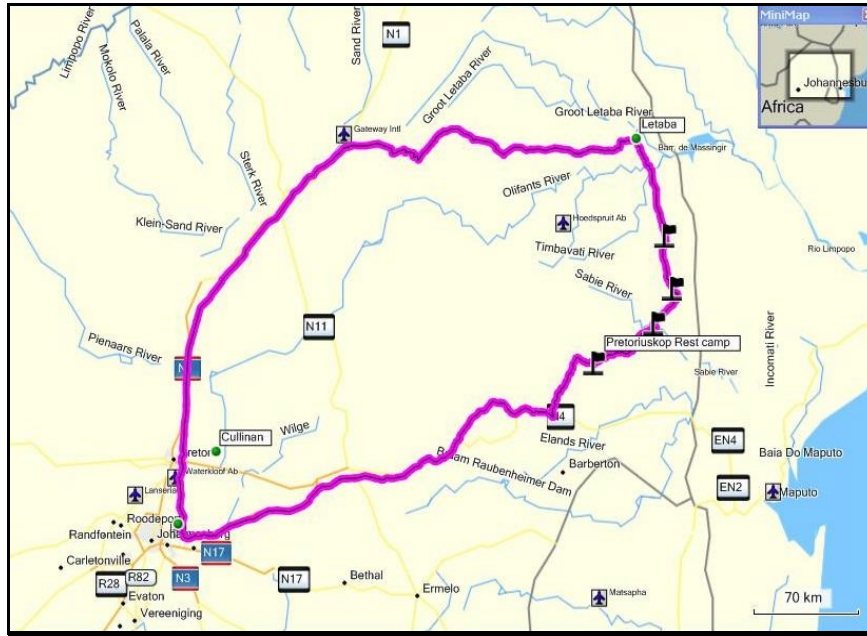

Passport Visa Requirements:

We will be travelling in South Africa:

- South Africa – Visas are generally required at the port of entry. You will be given a three month visa which is free of charge.

Items of interest:

- Total driving Distance: Approx 1,165 km (724 miles)
- Diesel consumption: 166 litres (44 US gallons) per vehicle

3 - day Itinerary – South Africa Kruger National Park

Meal Key: B – Breakfast, L – Lunch, D – Dinner

Day 1 & 2: Johannesburg to Numbi Gate (Kruger National Park) – Pretoriuskop Rest Camp

After arrival we meet and it's time to spot wild animals.

The roads are in excellent condition and you'll encounter all kinds of different animals during your drive. Stop at one of the many camps or rest stops along the way to stretch out for a bit. Drive over paved and unpaved roads towards Pretoriuskop Rest camp. This is where you'll set up your roof tent on top of your Land Rover and spend the night with the sounds of the animals sending you off into a deep and dreamy sleep.

Approximate distance: 390 km
Accommodation: Pretoriuskop Rest Camp
Meals: L, D

Day 3: Pretoriuskop Rest camp - North to Letabe Rest Camp

Now you're in the middle of your Kruger itinerary. Wake up early to make the most of today; we'll be travelling north towards Letaba Rest Camp enjoying the ever changing scenery in your Landy. You'll be driving over unpaved roads to your next accommodation: a small farm located in the middle of the bush.

You shouldn't have any problem spotting animals; the Kruger is known for the large number of animals roaming the land.

Approximate distance: 215
Accommodation: Letaba Rest Camp
Meals: B, L, D

Day 4 & 5: Letaba Rest Camp To Johannesburg

Today is our last day and our drive back to the South African Capital. We will have time for breakfast, pack away our camping equipment, when we are done you will take your roof tent down for last time and the last leg of your itinerary to Johannesburg arriving early afternoon.

Approximate distance: 560 km
Accommodation: Your hotel in Johannesburg
Meals: B, L

– End Of Services –

Arrival:

You will be met at the airport and transferred to your accommodation (where required).

Departure:

If you require an airport transfer this will be arranged for you.

Transport:

Chimhavira Overland Safaris cc use fully equipped 4x4 Land Rover Defender/Discovery vehicles.

Accommodation:

Accommodation will be in your vehicle roof top tents. Should you want to upgrade please ask your guide to assist you. Where possible your guide will try to upgrade you as to your requirements but this will be dependant on availability. Please note upgrades are not included in your Chimhavira Overland Safari cc invoice and will therefore necessitate you paying for upgrades directly.

Spending money:

Clients are advised to bring enough money to cover the purchase of curios and personal items.

Meals:

All meals are organized by the guide and are prepared by our cook. Meals are nutritious and filling, drawing on fresh local produce where possible. We buy groceries along the way, so our clients have a say in what type of meals are eaten. Please advise us of any special dietary requirements before tour commencement.

First Aid:

Our guides are trained in basic first aid, Chimhavira Overland Safari cc guides are trained to level III St John's or equivalent standard, our vehicles is equipped with a comprehensive medical aid kit. Preventative Malaria medication should be taken before the trip and throughout its duration, although it is advisable to consult a doctor prior to departure.

Luggage:

Maximum baggage allowance: 20kg. Chimhavira Overland Safaris cc stipulates this luggage allowance, as an overloaded vehicle is a danger to both the clients and the guide. This does not include photographic equipment and a small daypack. Please bring a backpack or soft barrel bag, not a suitcase. Please adhere to the allowance specified as space for luggage is limited.

Sleeping bags:

Chimhavira Overland Safaris cc can provide sleeping bags and pillows, please advise us if this is required at your time of booking. If you prefer to bring your own please feel free to do so.
